

CHILDREN'S LITURGY OF THE WORD (CLOW)

Children's Liturgy of the Word is held during the 10:00 am Mass from September through May. Following the opening prayer at Mass, the children are dismissed to Cartwright Hall beneath the church to hear the readings of the day from the Children's lectionary and to learn about them on a child's level. The children

return to the church for the rest of the Mass following the homily. This is a great way for children to learn about the Word of God each week when they attend Mass with their family.

CHILDREN'S LITURGY OF THE WORD (CLOW) LEADER: A CLOW leader leads the session during the 10:15 am Sunday Mass for children who participate in CLOW. This is a time when the children (usually from age 3 -10) go to a separate space in the Church (Cartwright Hall) with adult leaders to hear and discuss the readings of the day on their level. There are activities and time for them to lead prayer with each other. Materials and a leader's guide are provided to help plan the sessions. At this time leaders volunteer about once a month.
